Warm Weather a Harbinger of an Early Chicago Kitten Season: How You Can Help!

In 2016, more than 3400 stray and 1800 owner-surrendered cats entered CACC – 85 percent of these cats were rescued or adopted. Many were kittens. When kitten season gears up in the spring, and lasts through the warm summer months and into fall, CACC employees, cat transfer team, and Homeward Boundapproved partners need a lot of help to keep these vulnerable populations alive and well. Given the unseasonably warm temperatures early this year, we are already starting to see some mothers and kittens coming through the door.

Kittens on Deck Program:

Without CACC's partnerships with local rescues, many neonates would be euthanized, as they would not be able to live through the night when CACC is closed. The smallest neonatal babies need to be fed every few hours around the clock and even kittens up to six weeks need careful monitoring and assistance until they are fully weaned. CACC's Kittens on Deck program helps the most vulnerable get a second chance by engaging a rapid response team when orphaned neonatal or "bottle baby" kittens arrive at CACC. CACC's animal placement coordinators and cat transfer team communicate with rescues soon after the kittens' arrival, and CACC stays open until 10:00 p.m. for late-night transfers to our rescue partners so the kittens can get the round-the-clock care they need to survive and thrive.
