Welcome to CACC's new monthly newsletter, where you'll learn more about your City shelter, and how you can help Chicago's animals!

Located at 2741 S. Western Avenue, CACC is Chicago's openadmission municipal shelter, which means we do not turn away any animal irrespective of health or behavioral condition. CACC also provides animal control services. In 2015, more than 17,500 animals were impounded at the shelter. These animals included strays, ownersurrendered pets, those deemed dangerous under the law, animals confiscated for abuse and neglect, wildlife, and exotic animals.

CACC partners with volunteers and organizations to help many of these animals find placement or homes. For example, **CACC's Homeward Bound-approved rescues** transfer many of these animals into their organizations. CACC also partners with **Safe Humane Chicago**, an organization that provides a number of in-shelter programs to enrich the lives of dogs in our care. CACC partner **Friends of CACC** is dedicated to providing the shelter with resources that have a direct positive impact!

Additionally, every Sunday from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at CACC, the **Chicagoland Rescue Intervention and Support Program (CRISP)** provides resources, counseling, and other assistance to pet owners.
