This Department is requesting that the Contractor perform the following additional work discovered while performing Phase "A" work for this project:

Remove and replace 8" water main valve and vault not shown on the original contract drawings. Maintain traffic control and support for excavations for 16 additional days while City crews remove and replace nonfunctioning 24" water main valve.

Remove one 24" water main valve and two 6" blow off valves.

Install additional H piles to avoid obstructions due to relocation of connection structure to the west. Perform additional hand excavation required at existing ComEd duct bank and provide diagonal supports for duct bank due to relocation of connection structure to the west.

Install additional 5' of 12" ductile iron water main during installation of 12" to 8" water main reducer due to relocation of connection structure to the west.

Remove and replace 24" x 12" water main cross fitting and route 12" water main over 24" water main. Install 12" x 15" stainless steel repair sleeve and additional support for excavation at this location.

Install additional 20' of 24" water main at this location as well as flushing and inspection of 12" and 24" pipes.

Estimated duration of this Project is (14) fourteen Weeks.


