The Board of Ethics has received your request for an advisory opinion to determine whether you are eligible to obtain a city contract for the purpose of implementing the [REDACTED] Ordinance.

As a Board member of the [REDACTED] Commission, your conduct is governed by Executive Order 86-1. Section 12 of the Executive Order prohibits city officials from maintaining a financial interest in any city contract unless the contract is wholly unrelated to the official's city duties. It is apparent that the consulting contract which you wish to obtain to implement the [REDACTED] Ordinance is intimately related to your membership on the [REDACTED] Conversion Commission. Thus, you are not eligible to obtain this city contract unless you resign from your position as an appointed official on the [REDACTED] Commission.
