- The Center for Community Investment (CCI) hosted and sponsored my travel expenses related to my participation in the upcoming Learning Community as part of their 5-city 3C network. I was one (1) of five (5) team members (non-for profit and profit developers, philanthropic and public representative) representing 3C collaboration in Chicago led by Chicago Community Trust (CCT) for the past two years.
