## BEFORE YOU RIDE IN A PEDICAB

Pedicab vehicles must be licensed in the city of Chicago

- Pedicab vehicles must display pedicab license plate and current licensing decal at all times
- Pedicab chauffeurs must wear and display pedicab chauffeur license photo ID card at all times
- Pedicabs may not operate on sidewalks
- Pedicabs may not operate in the Loop during weekday rush hours (between 7 a.m. and 9 a.m. and between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m.)
- Pedicabs <u>are not permitted at all</u> on Michigan Avenue and State Street from Congress Parkway to Oak Street
- Drinking alcoholic beverages while operating or being transported by a pedicab is prohibited
- Fare schedules/cost of pedicab service must be visibly posted on pedicabs
- Proof of mandated insurance coverage must be kept in the pedicab
- Pedicab passengers must remain seated
- Pedicabs must have seat belts for passengers to use
- Pedicabs must have head-lights, tail-lights, brake-lights, and rim reflectors
