THE CHICAGO DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AFFAIRS AND CONSUMER PROTECTION (BACP) ENSURES A FAIR AND VIBRANT MARKET PLACE FOR BOTH BUSINESSES AND CONSUMERS.

BACP investigators inspect businesses and issue violations, where necessary, to ensure compliance with City laws.

BACP INVESTIGATORS EXAMINE:

- Filling Stations' Rules
 - o Ensure all gas pumps and scales are properly sealed
- · Retailers' Rules
 - Scan for outdated merchandise offered for sale on the premises (i.e. shelf-stable products, perishable foods, over-the-counter medicine)
 - Ensure proper price marking and display
 - Observe a refund and return policy
 - Review receipt information and tax compliance
 - Confirm compliance with plastic bag recycling (i.e. maintains a recycling bin and the sales of carryout reusable bags)
- Tobacco Sellers' Rules
 - Check for the sales or storage of illegal tobacco products (i.e. unstamped cigarettes, flavored liquid nicotine, cigarettes wraps)
 - Review records for all tobacco products stored and offered for sale
 - Request for safes and locked doors to be unlocked on the premises
 - Conduct investigations regarding the sales of tobacco products to minors which includes checking the required warning sign is conspicuously posted
- Compliance with face mask mandate (as of 08.20.21 until further notice)
