EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2021:

1. <u>Updated Security Protocols</u>: Maintain safeguards to protect passengers, the driver, and the public for trips transporting 15 or more passengers with an opportunity to drink alcohol at a stop or on the bus. New framework differentiates trips for transportation for corporate events, tourism and family events from trips encouraging drinking and recreational activity on the bus.

2. <u>Opens up opportunity for more individuals to be (livery and charter/sightseeing drivers)</u>: Maintain public safety by applying an equity framework distinguishing conviction of non-violent offenses from violent crimes. Note: an individual with CDL passenger endorsement does not require a separate restricted public chauffeur license to drive a charter/sightseeing vehicle.
