2018 West Walton Ukrainian Village District Extension New Construction

The historic development of this residential block includes primarily 1½-story Kerfoot cottages. This vacant lot sat within a row of nine Kerfoot cottages, and these cottages display only slight variations of roof heights, stoop heights, materials, and façade designs. The "Kerfoot cottage" is named for W.D. Kerfoot, a well-known real estate developer who was significant in the original development of this area. This new construction project is a good example of fitting within the constraints of a unified historic streetscape. The single-family house has a similar massing, uses compatible materials, and its design is in keeping with the architectural character of the adjacent historic cottages. The Ukrainian Village District Extension was designated a Chicago Landmark on April 11, 2007.
