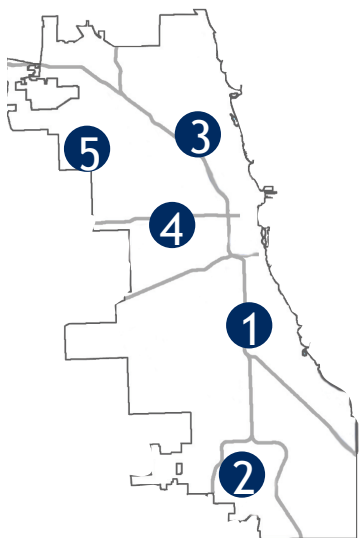


PHARMACEUTICAL DISPOSAL: BE SAFE AT HOME

You can also take your household chemicals, computers and non-controlled substances to the City's permanent Household Chemicals & Computer Recycling Facility at 1150 N. North Branch St.

(two blocks east of the Kennedy Expressway at Division Street).

HOURS: Tuesdays (7:00 am–12:00 pm), Thursdays (2:00 pm–7:00 pm), and the first Saturday of every month (8:00 am–3:00 pm)

The Chicago Pharmaceutical Collection Program is a joint effort of the City of Chicago Department of Environment (CDOE) and the Chicago Police Department to assist residents with the proper disposal of pharmaceuticals. The collected pharmaceuticals are processed by CDOE's hazardous waste hauler and disposed of by CDOE's contractors at the Household Chemicals and Computer Recycling Facility.
