

CITY of CHICAGO NOTICE OF A VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2021 ACTON PLAN AND 2022 FINAL ACTION PLAN

The City of Chicago's Office of Budget and Management, along with various HUD-Funded City Departments, will host a public hearing on the 2022 Draft Action Plan, which includes \$115,987,089 in funding from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to provide resources to low-and-moderate income people and communities across the Chicago. This public hearing will also include a review the Substantial Amendment to the 2021 Action Plan, which includes new funds received under the American Rescue Plan (ARP) to support the HOME Investment Partnership program in the amount of \$71,171,000. This hearing will inform residents of eligible and priority funding categories and allow the public to provide input on the recommended uses of the funding received by HUD.

The 2022 Action Plan in the amount of \$115,987,089 (*base funding), includes the following programs:

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG): \$76,233,776
- ❖ HOME Partnership Investment program (HOME and HOME-CV): \$21,593,700
- Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA): \$11,426,755
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG): \$6,732,858

HOME ARP funding in the amount of \$71,171,000; eligible funding categories are:

- Supportive Services
- ❖ Acquisition and Development of Non-Congregate Shelters
- Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA)
- Development of Affordable Housing
- ❖ Non-Profit Operating
- Non-Profit Capacity Building
- Administration and Planning
