Narratives

Disaster Damage:

The storm system that swept through Chicago and surrounding suburbs on April 17-18, 2013 produced approximately 5.5 inches of rain, or the equivalent of a 10-year storm. The heavy rains experienced resulted in sewer overflows, basement floods, and backflow of water from the Chicago River into Lake Michigan. The excessive rainfall that entered the sewer system could not flow fast enough to a wastewater treatment plant or a combined sewer outfall. By early morning of April 18, before the largest rainfall, the Tunnel and Reservoir Plan (TARP) tunnels, also known as the deep tunnels, were filled, which resulted in combined sewer overflows at 132 separate outfall locations. To prevent overland flooding the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRD) and the Army Corp of Engineers opened the Chicago River controlling locks for nearly 23 hours, leading to a discharge of over 10.7 billion gallons into Lake Michigan.

However, the April storms produced such heavy rains that the combined sewers overflowed and released untreated waste and stormwater. As sewer water rose above drain openings that were below street grade, water backed up into homes and other buildings. Basement flooding occurred citywide, with the City receiving over 2,500 water-in-basement calls and over 800 water-in-streets calls from residents from all 50 wards

The flooding also significantly impacted Chicago's infrastructure and resulted in the City receiving 571 calls of flooded streets and 32 calls of flooded viaducts. The Department of Streets and Sanitation relocated 105 vehicles to remove them from flooded areas. The Chicago Transit Authority received calls regarding flooded train stations. The rain and related flooding caused major road closures, including the following interstate highways and major city thoroughfares: I-94 northbound at the Kennedy Junction; I-94 southbound at Dempster Avenue; I-94 northbound between Foster and Touhy; I-94 northbound at 130th Street; Bishop Ford Expressway experienced major backups with lanes closures; 96thand Dorchester due to a sinkhole; Midway Plaisance eastbound; Belmont Avenue ramp to northbound Lake Shore Drive; Viaducts on Stoney Island, 95th Street and Cottage Grove Avenue.

Recovery Needs:

To aid in recovery efforts of community areas that were most impacted by the storms, the City has committed the majority of CDBG-DR funding toward public way infrastructure restoration, specifically to the water, sewer and drainage system which will bring these areas to resilience. These funds will specifically address infrastructure limitations and underlying conditions that contribute to the flooding of residences.

The City committed the remainder to provide direct assistance to housing rehabilitation for homeowners and renters, as well as mitigation measures. This initiative will prioritize residents with FEMA-verified loss and documented unmet needs who are low- and moderate-income residents.

Overall Progress Narrative:

During Q1 2017, the City continued to make progress towards the implementation of all CDBG-DR funded projects. 8 sewer improvement projects completed the construction portion of the project. 4 of those projects will complete the street restoration portion of the project in the spring, due to weather constraints. The Albany Park Tunnel project began construction in Q2 2016 and continues to make progress. The Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) was delivered to the site in January 2017, lowered into the starter tunnel through the outlet shaft, tested and commissioned. The TBM was launched and has begun mining tunnel rock at the outlet. WPA streets projects are still in the design phase, with construction anticipated to begin later in 2017.

The Residential Flooding Assistance Program (RFAP) subrecipients have conducted significant outreach to potential beneficiaries (more than 384 potential beneficiaries contacted). All 56 projects were completed in Q1 2017, however a few are completing the vouchering process into Q2.

In Q2 2017, the City will be continuing to closely monitor all extended round two and three projects and make adjustments as necessary to ensure the timely expenditure of funds.

To address the damage created by the April 2013 storms in the West Side Demonstration Area (WSDA), a series of concentrated stormwater landscapes will be constructed along selected corridors. These new landscapes will divert stormwater from the City's combined sewer system and provide multiple community benefits to residents that are vulnerable to basement and street flooding.

Location Description:

The demonstration area is comprised of six West Side communities, Austin, Humboldt Park, East Garfield, West Garfield, North Lawndale and South Lawndale, referred to as the West Side Demonstration Area (WSDA). The specific locations will be identified through the environmental analysis process.

Activity Progress Narrative:

An environmental team has been conducting an analysis to determine the best parcels and strategy for this project. The following analyses have been completed: (1) Phase I environmental investigations, (2) modeling using the City's stormwater modeling tool to locate areas where green infrastructure would have the biggest impact, and (3) stormwater flowpath analysis identifying how the stormwater is traveling within the corridors. Numerous meetings have been held with community stakeholders in each corridor to discuss community needs and interests for the landscapes as well to identify community groups and stakeholders that will maintain the landscapes. It is anticipated that construction will begin in late Q2, early Q3 2017.

Activity Description:

To improve storm water management, the City will construct green storm water infrastructure features on WPA streets to provide a location to store water, thus reducing flooding in the neighborhood. Based on the configuration of each street, the City will build an infiltration trench and/or a bioswale that will capture storm water. Infiltration trenches are located in the parking lane of the road and are designed to include permeable pavement that directs water into a gravel bed below the road surface. Bioswales are located in the parkway between the road and the sidewalk and use plants, trees, and a drainage bed of soil and gravel to capture and filter storm water runoff from the street. The City will also repave these streets so that the pitch of the road surface directs storm water runoff into the infiltration trench and bioswale.

Location Description:

East 94th Street between South Woodlawn and South Kimbark Ave

Activity Progress Narrative:

Project is completing design phase, incorporating "green" storm water infrastructure features. The environmental review process was completed in Q4 2016. Construction is expected to begin in 2017. The City requested an extension to reflect the delays experienced in the design and environmental review process.
