Narratives

Disaster Damage:

The storm system that swept through Chicago and surrounding suburbs on April 17-18, 2013 produced approximately 5.5 inches of rain, or the equivalent of a 10-year storm. The heavy rains experienced resulted in sewer overflows, basement floods, and backflow of water from the Chicago River into Lake Michigan. The excessive rainfall that entered the sewer system could not flow fast enough to a wastewater treatment plant or a combined sewer outfall. By early morning of April 18, before the largest rainfall, the Tunnel and Reservoir Plan (TARP) tunnels, also known as the deep tunnels, were filled, which resulted in combined sewer overflows at 132 separate outfall locations. To prevent overland flooding the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRD) and the Army Corp of Engineers opened the Chicago River controlling locks for nearly 23 hours, leading to a discharge of over 10.7 billion gallons into Lake Michigan. However, the April storms produced such heavy rains that the combined sewers overflowed and released untreated waste and stormwater. As sewer water rose above drain openings that were below street grade, water backed up into homes and other buildings. Basement flooding occurred citywide, with the City receiving over 2,500 water-in-basement calls and over 800 water-in-streets calls from residents from all 50 wards.

The flooding also significantly impacted Chicago's infrastructure and resulted in the City receiving 571 calls of flooded streets and 32 calls of flooded viaducts. The Department of Streets and Sanitation relocated 105 vehicles to remove them from flooded areas. The Chicago Transit Authority received calls regarding flooded train stations. The rain and related flooding caused major road closures, including the following interstate highways and major city thoroughfares: I-94 northbound at the Kennedy Junction; I-94 southbound at Dempster Avenue; I-94 northbound between Foster and Touhy; I-94 northbound at 130th Street; Bishop Ford Expressway experienced major backups with lanes closures; 96thand Dorchester due to a sinkhole; Midway Plaisance eastbound; Belmont Avenue ramp to northbound Lake Shore Drive; Viaducts on Stoney Island, 95th Street and Cottage Grove Avenue.

Recovery Needs:

To aid in recovery efforts of community areas that were most impacted by the storms, the City has committed the majority of CDBG-DR funding toward public way infrastructure restoration, specifically to the water, sewer and drainage system which will bring these areas to resilience. These funds will specifically address infrastructure limitations and underlying conditions that contribute to the flooding of residences.

The City committed the remainder to provide direct assistance to housing rehabilitation for homeowners and renters, as well as mitigation measures. This initiative will prioritize residents with FEMA-verified loss and documented unmet needs who are low- and moderate-income residents.

Overall Progress Narrative:

During Q3 2016, the City continued to make progress towards the implementation of all CDBG-DR funded projects. A total of 3 sewer projects were awarded, bringing the total up to nine. Another 3 sewer projects went out to bid and will be awarded in Q4. The Albany Park Tunnel project began construction in Q2 and continues to make progress to bring in the tunnel boring machine in Q1 2017. The Residential Flooding Assistance Program (RFAP) subrecipients have conducted significant outreach to potential beneficiaries (more than 384 potential beneficiaries contacted). 61 beneficiaries have completed the application process and been approved, and 40 grant agreements and liens were executed by all required parties. The remaining agreements/liens will be completed early in Q4 and construction is scheduled to be completed as well in Q4.

The City also requested a grant agreement amendment in Q3 to move already expended second round administration and infrastructure funds to ensure the timely expenditure of the second round allocation. Though the City requested an extension for the first allocation the City was able to expend all round one funding prior to the expenditure deadline. The City also submitted an extension request for many round two activities in October to assist with the full implementation, monitoring and internal control process to be completed as necessary. In Q4, the City will be continuing to closely monitor all round two and three projects and make adjustments as necessary to ensure the timely expenditure of funds.

From the list of 70 clients, 62 client files were cancelled or are ineligible for a variety of reasons including lack of remaining unmet needs, not income eligible, or lack of interest in participation. Catholic Charities has conducted pre-construction meetings with all remaining 8 eligible owners and contractors and have issued notices to proceed for 6 projects; of these, 5 projects have started construction. Two projects already awarded, were awarded to the next lowest bidder after the originally selected contractor withdrew from both projects. These two owners are executing new Grant Agreements and Liens.

From the list of 124 clients, 102 client files were cancelled or are ineligible for various reasons including lack of interest in the program, beneficiary moved, and lack of income eligibility, leaving 22 households CNT will service. All 22 owners have executed Grant Agreements and Liens. CNT has conducted pre-construction meetings with all 22 owners and contractors and have issued notices to proceed for all 22 projects. 17 of the 22 projects have started construction. It is anticipated that all projects will be completed in Q4 2016.

Unfortunately, each of the agencies experienced a significant number of cancelled or ineligible clients. From a total list of 384 FEMA identified clients and referrals provided to the agencies, only 61 households will receive repair and mitigation assistance. Of the 61 households, 40 Grant Agreements and Liens were executed by all required parties. However, two owners of the 40 had to select new contractors after their original contractor withdrew from both projects for a total of 38 fully executed Grant Agreements and Liens. Both owners will execute new Grant Agreements and Liens reflecting the bid amounts of their new contractors. Winning bids for 58 projects have been determined and owners have selected their contractors. Notices to proceed have been issued for 28 of the 61 projects and 22 of these projects have started construction. The agencies continue to move forward with their pre-construction and construction process to meet the goal of having all projects completed by or before December 1st. The City did request an extension on some of the housing acitivities to allow for time to fully complete the internal vouchering process and allow for issues that may occur during the construction phase that may delay projects further.
