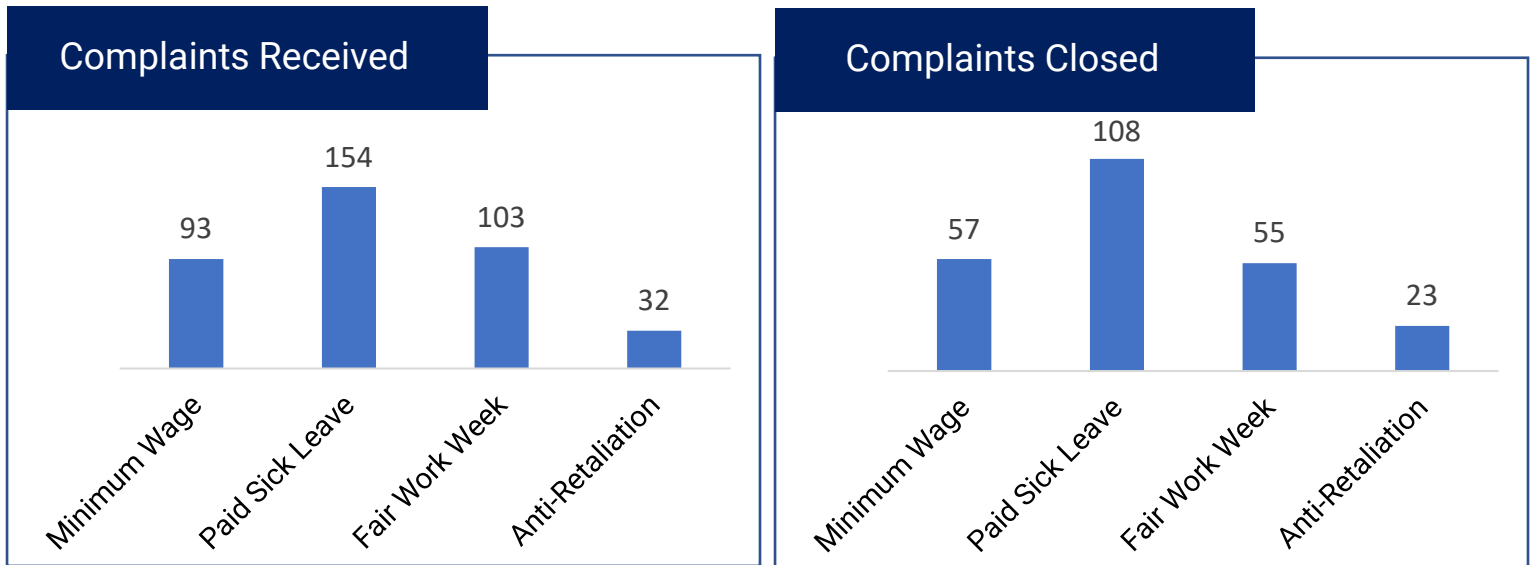

### 2021 Highlights

- Brought nine high profile cases against larger employers to protect the rights of 2,859 workers, realizing over \$1,000,000 in restitution directly to workers at over \$200,000 in fines to the City.
- Continued outreach and education programming by engaging with over 300 attendees through labor-related webinars. In addition, OLS participated in community-led trainings and local media interviews, including Spanish broadcasts, reaching the City's most vulnerable workers.

No license applications were denied nor were any licenses suspended or revoked pursuant to Section 4-4-320(a) for violations of the Illinois Wage Payment and Collection Act or Chapter 1-24 of the Municipal Code of Chicago
