BEFORE YOU RIDE IN A **PEDICAB**


Pedicab vehicles must be licensed in the **city of Chicago**

- **Pedicab vehicles must display pedicab license plate and current licensing decal at all times**
- Pedicab chauffeurs must wear and display pedicab chauffeur license photo ID card at all times
- **Pedicabs may not operate on sidewalks**
- Pedicabs may not operate in the Loop during weekday rush hours (between 7 a.m. and 9 a.m. and between 4 p.m. and 6 p.m.)
- **Pedicabs are not permitted at all on Michigan Avenue and State Street from Congress Parkway to Oak Street**
- Drinking alcoholic beverages while operating or being transported by a pedicab is prohibited
- **Fare schedules/cost of pedicab service must be visibly posted on pedicabs**
- Proof of mandated insurance coverage must be kept in the pedicab
- **Pedicab passengers must remain seated**
- Pedicabs must have seat belts for passengers to use
- **Pedicabs must have head-lights, tail-lights, brake-lights, and rim reflectors**
