This Department is requesting that the Contractor make immediate repairs to to the facade on the south elevation of the Chemical Building at SWPP. Prior to performing the work install temporary wood protective shielding on the low roof that is adjacent to the work area on the south elevation as well as above the monorail beam and double entry door at the north corner of the east elevation in order to protect from falling debris.

Three types of repairs are described below:

1. Re-affix displaced panels to the structure utilizing specified stainless steel anchors.

2. Clean and prepare specified limestone horizontal and vertical joints for sealant. Apply specified primer and joint sealant.

3. Install limestone dutchman repair at the specified location.

Estimated duration of this Project is (3) three Weeks.

The south elevation of the Chemical Building at SWPP requires immediate repairs of the limestone facade panels. During demolision work along the west side of this building, an existing dutchman repair fell and several limestone wall panels and top coping pieces have been determined to be loose and need to be secured to the structure.

2. Please explain why this project could not be bid using the city's traditional bid process and the need to use JOC Procurement system.

In September 2007 an existing dutchman repair fell from the south elevation of the Chemical Building. The remaining limestone panels on this elevation need to be checked and secured if found to be loose. Phase B of this project is for immediate repairs to this wall. JOC is the quickest way to make these immediade repairs since the Contractor has already been on site with the Phase A work and is familiar with the repair procedures.

3. If the project is a one trade project, please provide additional explanation of why it would not be in the city's best interest to do the project under JOC.


