As part of the Chicago Fire Department's homeland security strategy, I, Devon Flynn, File# 21916 assigned to Ambulance 63 (District EMS North, Battalion EMS 4) in the Bureau of Operations attended the Emergency Medical Operations for CBRNE Incidents (EMO) course, from 4/23/2023 to 4/29/2023 at the Domestic Preparedness Training Center (CDP) in Anniston, Alabama.
