12. Is there anything in place to address circumstances where two hearing officers will hear the same issues and rule differently.

As of April 22, 2012, a change was deployed in the parking ticket hearing system which addressed the situation of a respondent requesting a contest by mail hearing for more than one parking citation for the same violation. If this occurs, the same ALJ will have the ability to adjudicate all tickets at the same time.

13. Do hearing officers or any Administrative Hearings staff check calls to 311 regarding broken meters or signs down (i.e., does the department staff verify information presented to them)? Is this done as a matter of routine?

Administrative Law Judges have access to the meter repair database and will use it if the information supports the respondent’s case. However, ALJs are trained not to rely solely on this database when making credibility determinations. For example, if the respondent testifies that the meter was malfunctioning, but the database reflects that there was no service call or that the meter was inspected and found to be in proper working order, the ALJ must consider all evidence presented. This could result in a finding of liability against the respondent. ALJs do not have access to any information regarding missing or non-posted signage. Respondents gather this documentation from CDOT via the FOIA process and present the evidence at their hearing.
