2021 Wrigley Field Cubs Game Transportation Restrictions

- Chicago's Office of Emergency Management and Communications (OEMC) & Chicago
 Police Department (CPD)'s traffic management and public safety map of designated
 areas Transportation Network Provider vehicles & driver and Pedicabs can pick up
 and drop off passengers.
- The restrictions detailed in the map apply 2 hours before and 1.5 hours after **games** and concerts at Wrigley Field.
