EXPIRED Taxicab Medallion Licenses

Pursuant to Municipal Code of Chicago section 9-112-150, taxicab medallion licenses that have not renewed are EXPIRED and in VIOLATION of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

Taxicab medallion license holders are NOT permitted to operate taxicabs with expired taxicab medallion licenses. Taxicab medallion license holders who have not renewed for the current licensing term must:

- Complete license renewal for current license term; OR (1)
- Surrender both the associated taxicab medallion metal plate and (2) taxicab medallion license (hard) card.

Licenses may be renewed or surrendered between 8:30am and 4:30pm weekdays at the Public Vehicle Operations Facility, 2350 W. Ogden, First Floor.

Only taxicab medallion license holders who have renewed and have active current Taxicab Medallion Licenses may operate their vehicles as taxicabs.

Licensees should contact the Department of Finance to explore payment plan options to resolve outstanding debt.

Taxicabs operating without an active current license in good standing are subject to citations resulting in fines, medallion metal plate confiscation, vehicle impoundment, and/or revocation.
