## CHICAGO'S COVID GUIDELINES ARE THE LAW

## **REMINDER:**

All public chauffeurs are required to wear masks/face coverings while transporting passengers in public passenger vehicles (taxicabs, transportation network or ride-hail vehicles, liveries, tour boats, chartersightseeing vehicles, etc.).

Currently, recipients of COVID-19 vaccinations are not exempt from wearing face coverings as required. Click here for "Guidance on the Use of Face Coverings".

The Chicago Department of <u>Public Health's Order 2020-9</u> mandates face coverings/masks be worn in shared spaces and Chicago's COVID guidelines be followed. Violations are subject to fines and license suspensions.
