## FACE COVERINGS ARE STILL REQUIRED IN <u>PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION</u>

## **REMINDER:**

All public chauffeurs and passengers are required to wear masks/face coverings while transporting passengers in public passenger vehicles (taxicabs, transportation network or ride-hail vehicles, liveries, tour boats, charter-sightseeing vehicles, etc.).

Recipients of COVID-19 vaccinations are NOT exempt from wearing face coverings as required IN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION.
