Face coverings are required in public transportation, including taxicabs, liveries, charter buses and transportation network (ride-hail) vehicles.

2021 The Twelve Bars of Christmas (TBOX) TNP, Taxi, Charter, and Livery NO drop-off or pick-up zones Saturday, December 11, 2021 (0700hrs) *until* Sunday, December 12, 2021 (0300hrs)



The Office of Emergency Management and Communications (OEMC), in conjunction with the Chicago Police Department (CPD), is requesting the following to ensure public safety during TBOX 2021:

- Taxis, TNPs, Charters, and liveries must not drop-off and pick-up within the geofence boundaries marked in Red (except WAV with ADA passengers).
- Pick-ups or Drop-offs are allowed with reasonable wait time and no double parking on the north curb of Addison (Sheffield to Clark) and the east curb of Clark (Addison to Waveland) marked in Green.

No vehicles stopping, standing, or parking in bus or bicycle lanes, active traffic lanes, intersections, fire lanes, sidewalk crossings, turning lanes, etc. (Strictly enforced)
