TAP CARD DO'S & DON'TS

DO'S

- TAP riders must present their TAP card for payment and retain possession of their TAP card.
- Contact your dispatch to process a manual transaction if a TAP card does not work when swiped.
- Collect payment from TAP riders for all extras and/or when the taximeter exceeds \$30. (The TAP card maximum subsidy is \$30. Taxi drivers are responsible for collecting payment.)
- TAP trips must begin in the City of Chicago.

DON'TS

- Do not charge flat rates for TAP trips. (Metered fares only)
- Do not idle while performing TAP trips. (Taxi drivers cannot wait for passengers while the meter is still running.)
- Do not chain trips. (There must be a minimum of 10 minutes between performing TAP trips for the same riders.)
- TAP fares cannot originate in the suburbs.

TAP riders must swipe their TAP card each time when exiting the vehicle. Riders are the only person permitted to use the TAP Card. TAP cards are the property of Pace Suburban Bus.

TAP participation may be terminated without notice for violating the TAP rules. Violations will be reported to City of Chicago Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP). Proven fraud will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
