## How to access Hotels and McCormick Place during this Sunday's Hot Chocolate 15k Race

**Event:** Hot Chocolate 15k Race

**Date:** Sunday, October 29, 2017 – 6:00 am to 11:00 am

- Vehicles wishing to access downtown and near Northside hotels during Sunday morning's Hot Chocolate 15k Race can always use north Michigan Avenue or north State Street, since this Race uses Lower Wacker for part of their course. Both Michigan Avenue and State Street will be open and accessible north of Van Buren, during the race.
- Vehicles wishing to access McCormick Place during the Race can use Lake Shore Drive to the I-55 Stevenson Expressway. Then using the State St. Exit Turnaround, can re-enter inbound onto I-55, where vehicles will travel under the Race, as runners will pass overhead using Michigan Avenue. Vehicles can simply then exit inbound on I-55 at King Drive for immediate access to McCormick Place.
