REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL ("RFP") FOR THE CENTRALIZED WAV TAXICAB DISPATCH SERVICE

The City of Chicago (the "City") acting through the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection ("BACP") invites the submission of proposals in response to a Request For Proposals ("RFP") for operation of the City's centralized dispatch service for all wheelchair accessible vehicle (WAV) City of Chicago licensed taxicabs. Pursuant to Municipal Code of Chicago Section 9-112-570 "Taxicab wheelchair accessible vehicles and centralized wheelchair accessible dispatch", the Commissioner of BACP is authorized to regulate a centralized dispatch system for wheelchair accessible vehicle taxicabs. The chosen Respondent will be responsible for providing a centralized dispatch service for WAV taxicab vehicles as defined in the RFP.
