REMINDER: Maximum Credit Card Processing Fee is now 3%

Please note the following new law went into effect as of July 1, 2016

The maximum service fee/transaction fee charged to the lessee taxi chauffeur for the processing of electronic payments may not be greater than three percent (3%).
