NEW Taxicab and Public Passenger Vehicle Advertising Permitting On-Line Process

The Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP) has launched a new Web based on-line process for advertising companies, taxicab companies and public passenger vehicle companies to process and pay for advertising permits. Both exterior (taxicab roof-top and side door panel) and interior (video monitor) advertising permits may be secured through the new Web based portal.

The new on-line process allows any company to obtain multiple types of advertising permits in bulk.

Advertising permits may also be renewed efficiently on the new Web based portal.
