

List of Types or Categories of Records Under the Police Board's Control*

- Police disciplinary case records (the Board's final decisions of disciplinary cases since 2014 are available immediately upon request)
- Police Board meeting records (minutes and transcripts of public meetings since 2015 are available immediately upon request)
- Police Board member records
- Administrative files and miscellaneous correspondence
- Applications for employment and personnel records
- Budget and contract records
- Legal files
- Rules, regulations, policies, and procedures (those that are currently in effect are available immediately upon request)
- Reports, including annual, quarterly, and monthly reports (annual reports since 2004 and the most recent quarterly and monthly reports are available immediately upon request)
- Appeals from disqualified applicants to become a police officer
- Freedom of Information Act requests and responses

If a person who requests records stored solely in electronic format lacks knowledge as to how to view them, the office of the Police Board will make best efforts to make those records available for physical inspection or copying.
