The City of Chicago Department of Housing (DOH) proposes to provide funds from U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) Multi-Family Loan Program. The proposed project would rehabilitate the exterior and interior of the Island Terrace Apartments. Because the undertaking involves federal programs, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) considers those actions as the use of federal funds and therefore requires federal environmental review, including review requirements for potential historic resources. Please refer to the attached factsheet for additional details about the proposed undertaking and related site information.

In accordance with 24 CFR Part 58, the City of Chicago Department of Assets, Information, and Services (AIS) has received HUD delegated authority to provide environmental review responsibilities under the National Environmental Policy Act. AIS is the Responsible Entity for the environmental review of the proposed undertaking and is acting as the Agency Official with respect to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act.

The building located at 6430 S Stony Island Avenue is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). On December 2, 2022, the Illinois State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) determined that the some of the proposed alterations of the building and associated structures would constitute an adverse effect to historic resources.
