
- 1-4 owner-occupied properties (Note: condos, mixed-use properties, and 5+ unit properties do not qualify.)
- Must be the owner's primary and only residence.
- Homeowners who earn up to 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI).
- 80% AMI is approximately \$62,000-\$96,000 depending on your household size.
