SECTION I: CLARIFICATION TO QUESTIONS

Question 7:

Are the materials comingled at the transfer, if so who decides what's special and non-special?

Answer: No, materials are not combined. The City will have separate bins for waste.

Question 8:

Will the hauler be responsible for soil testing similar to Spec 338124? **Answer: No. The Contractor is not responsible for soil testing.**

Question 11:

Is the material coming from the Sewer and Water Department combined with new construction and demolition? **Answer: No, materials are not combined.**

Question 17:

Section 5.6 defines General Construction Debris. As defined, the materials may be disposed of at a CCDD facility. Will the City provide the required IEPA Forms 662 or 66 necessary for disposal at a CCDD? **Answer: No.**

Question:

All disposal sites need to know whether the load is clean or not. So, someone has to classify the load before the load is shipped to a disposal site. **Answer: The vendor must classify and is responsible once the debris has been picked up from the City's Transfer Station (as specified in Section 5.4)**
