Dear

On January 8, 1992, you telephoned to ask whether the Governmental Ethics Ordinance prohibits a Chicago school teacher from obtaining a planning and development loan from the City of Chicago.

After reviewing the facts and relevant Board opinions, the staff concluded that the Ordinance does not prohibit this individual from receiving a loan from the City. The Board of Education is established under the Illinois School Code, ILL. REV. STAT. ch. 122, para. 34. Chicago school teachers are employed by that Board and not by the City of Chicago. Therefore, a Chicago school teacher is not a City employee as defined by the Governmental Ethics Ordinance.

Our opinion is based on the application of the City's Governmental Ethics Ordinance to the facts stated in this letter. If the facts presented are incorrect or incomplete, please notify us immediately.

We appreciate your willingness to comply with the ethical standards embodied in the Governmental Ethics Ordinance, and enclose a copy of the Ordinance for you convenience. If you have any further questions, do not hesitate to contact us.
