


Near North Side Demographic Data

Applicant: Northwestern Memorial HealthCare Address: 201 - 221 E. Erie Street, 631 - 649 N. St. Clair Street, 200-212 E. Ontario Street Date of Introduction: September 21, 2022



- The project plan is to repurpose two Hotel floors (5th and 6th floors, 20,576 SF and 36 keys per floor) for outpatient Medical Service. Northwestern Health Care intends to reconfigure the elevators serving those floors, which would require removal of two hotel rooms on the seventh floor. The total reduction in hotel room keys by the repurposing the 5th and 6th floors to Medical.
- The project will also include a Pedestrian Bridge over East Erie. NMHC intends to construct a pedestrian bridge connecting the second-floor elevator lobby of the Hotel with Galter Pavilion.












### **LEVEL 1 FLOOR PLAN**

















### LEVEL 2 CONNECTION DIAGRAM


### **LEVEL 2 BRIDGE PLAN**

# **X** DPD Recommendations

DPD has concluded that this proposal is appropriate for this site and supports this amendment for the following reasons:

- The addition of "Medical Service" as a permitted use to PD 468 will not negatively impact the remaining uses on this site, adjacent uses to this site, nor uses in the immediate area.
- The addition of a pedestrian bridge to connect PD No. 3 and PD 468 will improve pedestrian connectivity for both patients and pedestrians.
